

Order No. 03-22-07
ELDORADO NATIONAL FOREST
BARRETT LAKE 4x4 TRAIL MOTOR VEHICLE PROHIBITION

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the Pacific Ranger District of the Eldorado National Forest. This Order is effective from May 1, 2022 through July 31, 2022, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.

Using any type of motor vehicle on Forest Service Trail No. 16E21 (Barrett Lake 4x4 Trail), as shown on the attached Exhibit. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(b).


Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order, Form FS-7700-48, specifically exempting them from this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. § 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571 and 3581.
